## **Re: NEW MEMBERS – Criteria and Procedure**

Detailed below are the Procedure and Criteria for New Members. It is important you fully review this information before proceeding. It is also important to know we have a Wait-list, and it may take more than one year, depending on your golf club's wait list.

We recommend you talk to your Club's Governor prior to proceeding with your application.

### **THE CANADIAN SENIORS' GOLF ASSOCIATION PROCEDURE TO IMPLEMENT MEMBERSHIP BY INVITATION**

To **obtain** an **application** form for **membership**, the sponsor should **contact his Governor, Administrator or download an application** from the website at [www.thecsga.ca](http://www.thecsga.ca). A full list of Governors is available on the website. The application form, once it is completed should be sent directly to the Administrator of the Association, along with Emails or letters from the Proposer and Secunder, giving fullest information concerning business and social affiliations and golf related information, as may be helpful to the Executive Committee in determining fitness for membership of the applicant. Both the Proposer and Secunder must be members for at least two years. An application for membership should not be sent and will not be recorded prior to the date on which the applicant reaches the age of fifty (50). The applicant will still have to be fifty-five (55) on the day prior to the Association's Annual Tournament before being accepted as a member.

The Administrator will acknowledge to the Proposer, Secunder and other references by Email, receipt of the properly completed application form. The application will be placed on file in order of receipt. Early each year, the Executive Committee will review all outstanding applications, and will submit its recommendations to the Board of Governors'. Those elected to membership will receive invitations from the Executive Director to join the Association and will become active members once they have paid the initiation fee and annual dues.

The fact that a candidates' name is maintained on the membership application list should not be interpreted as an assurance of his eventful election.

Members, before sponsoring a candidate for membership, should give careful attention to the "Criteria for the Membership Selection Process"

### **CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP SELECTION PROCESS**

The C.S.C.A. is an Association for gentlemen golfers across Canada, who are members in good standing of a golf club which is a member of Golf Canada. The object of the Association is to encourage friendly competition in golf among senior players, and to hold an Annual Golf Tournament.

Considerations to be given due weight in establishing a candidate's suitability:

- Contributions made by him to the development and maintenance of golf in its best traditions at the club, provincial or national level.
- His depth of experience as a golfer and his observance of the regulations and etiquette of golf.
- His golf index shall not exceed 18 at the time of application.
- Applications will be accepted if the applicant has reached the age of fifty (50). The applicant will still have to be fifty-five (55) before becoming eligible for membership. There is no upper age limit to join.
- Probable participation in C.S.G.A. events, particularly the Annual Tournament.
- His standing in the community and in his profession, business or other occupation, and the significant contributions, if any, he has made.
- He is a gentleman and fun to be with, before, during and after golf.

### **ANNUAL DUES & MEMBERSHIP INITIATION FEES**

New members are required to pay an initiation fee and annual dues upon membership acceptance.

2017 Annual Dues: \$155

2017 Membership Initiation Fee: \$240
